Virtual Participation

The Brent Woodall Foundation (BWF) relies heavily on the support of annual fundraisers to keep services at low cost to families of children with autism and other developmental disabilities. The Walkabout for Autism is the foundation's largest annual fundraiser.

Last year the BWF raised \$20,000 from the Walkabout. The original goal was \$15,000. After surpassing the first goal, we raised the bar and made it to \$20,000! Most of this was raised by the Woodallkids parents and families. How amazing is that?!

Woodallkids parents are their children's first and most important advocates. Help the BWF do it again and reach a fundraising goal of \$20,000 for the 10th annual Walkabout for Autism in September 2014. Here are ways that you can do it!

CrowdRise- the best and easiest way to help!

- 1. Go to https://www.crowdrise.com/10thwalkabout.
- 2. Click "Set Up Your Fundraiser" (left side of page).
- 3. Choose a catchy team name and fill out the Get Started page.
- 4. Upload a team profile picture.
- 5. Fund raise! Send your team's website url (ex: www.crowdrise.com/teamname) to friends and family and ask them to donate to your team for the 10th
 Walkabout for Autism! You can even be creative and come up with a funny idea to entice friends and family to support your goal. For example, one fundraiser shaved his head when his donors raised \$1,000 for his charity.
- 6. Manage your fundraiser. When logged in to your CrowdRise profile, you can View Fundraiser, Edit Fundraiser, and Manage Campaign. Go to Manage Campaign and click on the Donation Toolkit dropdown menu (bottom right hand corner) to update donations given to your team off line, to see who has donated, or to thank donors.
- 7. Go back to https://www.crowdrise.com/10thwalkabout and you will see your team listed as a team member.

Just Ask!

Asking for donations can be pretty scary. You might not think that anyone will donate. However, we are willing to bet that you will be quite surprised by how many positive responses you will get. All you have to do is ask politely. Explain to your friends and family what their contribution will go toward. Tell them how the BWF has helped you or inspired you. The worst that can happen is someone will not be able to donate... this year.

One particular Woodallkids Family sends out a flyer to all of their friends and family once a year. The flyer includes a photo of their child and asks that the reader donate to support the foundation in honor of the family's child. That Woodallkid no longer attends the BWF, but still participates in the Walkabout fundraiser every year. And for the past three years, that family has raised more than \$5,000. You can do it too! Attached to this document is a sample template of what you can send your friends and family.
