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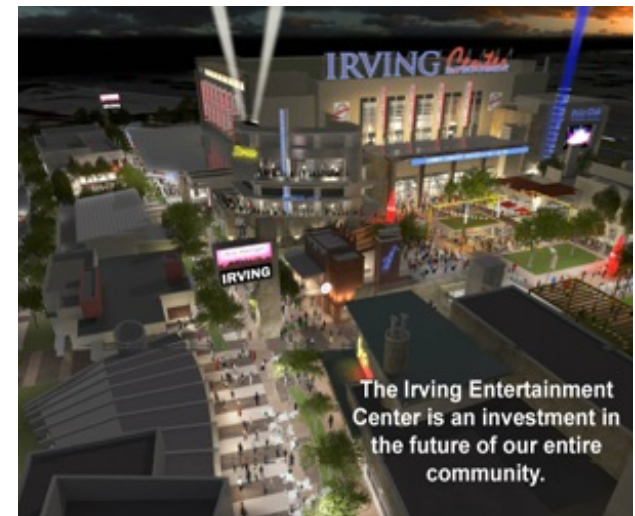
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WALKABOUT FUNDRAISER FOR AUTISM, FITNESS CELEBRATES WOODALL FOUNDATION'S 10TH YEAR

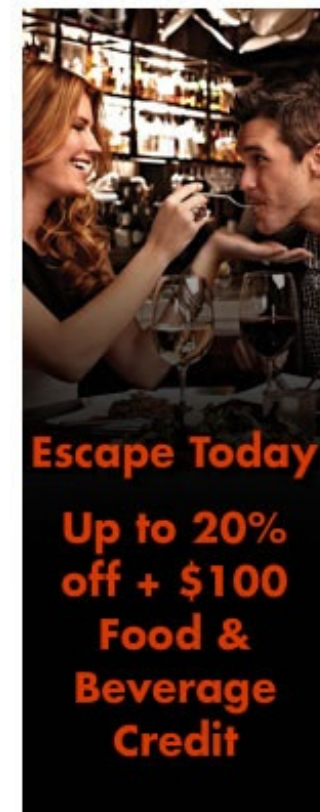
The Brent Woodall Foundation for Exceptional Children (BWF) will host its 8th Annual Walkabout for Autism and Fitness Challenge on Sep. 22 at the Andrew Brown Community Park East in Coppell.
